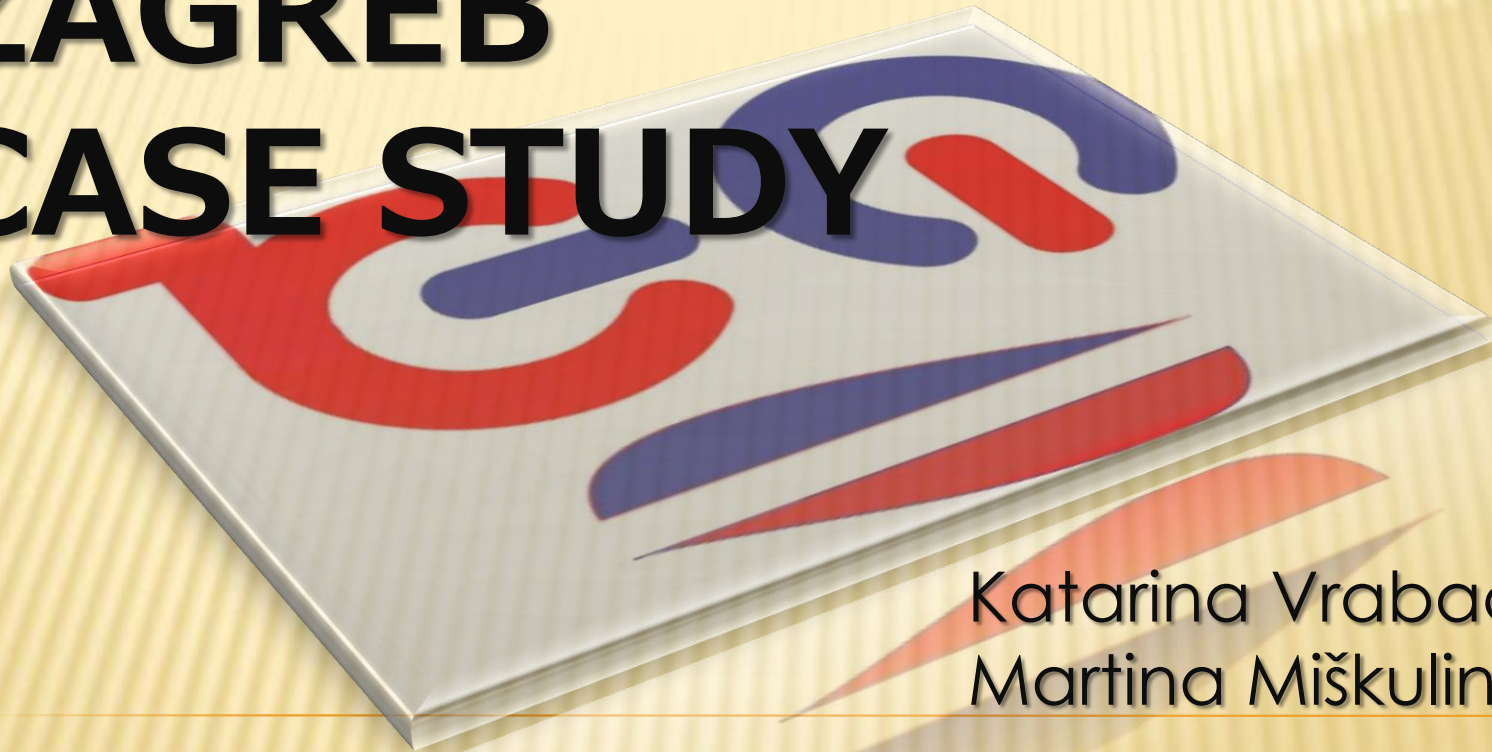

University of Zagreb:

- 65 000 students
- 200 students with disability

The Faculty of Philosophy

- 48 students

Faculty of Economics

- 20 students



OFFICE FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

- ✘ The office is designed for students:
 - ✘ • visually impaired
 - ✘ • with hearing impairments
 - ✘ • with physical disabilities
 - ✘ • with multiple disabilities
 - ✘ • chronic diseases
 - ✘ • with mental disorders
 - ✘ • with learning disabilities (dyslexia, dysgraphia, etc.)
 - ✘ • with other medical conditions or disabilities that may affect the course of study.



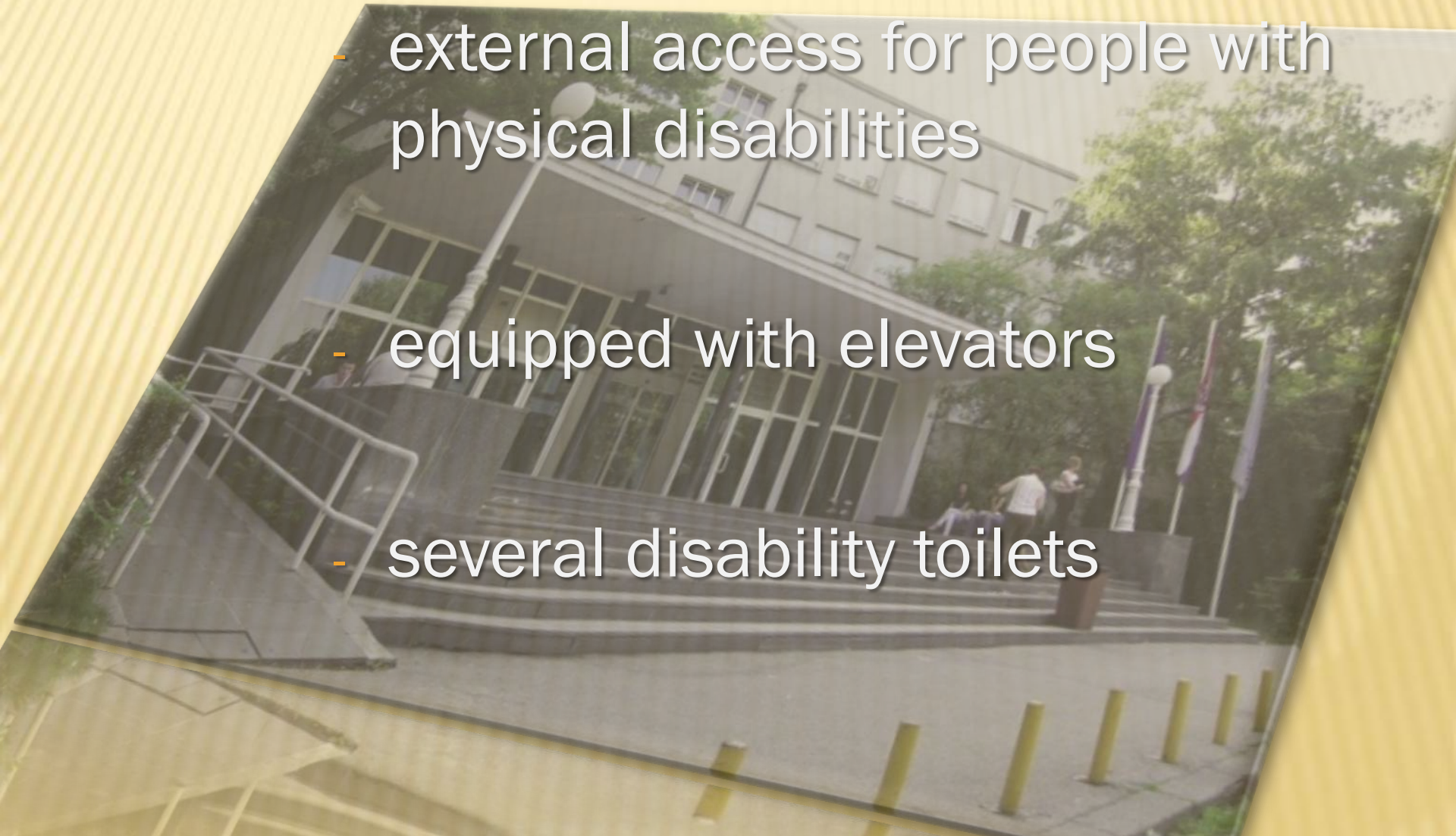
FACULTY OF PHILOSOPHY
